#### **Proposed Federal Accessibility Legislation**

The Trade and Convention Centre was the Vancouver site for the Federal Consultation on proposed legislation for accessibility for people with disabilities in Canada.

- Nearly 200 people attended the Saturday afternoon session on Nov 26th, encompassing a cross section of types of disabilities, and many of them wished to speak.
- Representing CHHA were Drs. Marilyn Dahl, Charles Laszlo and Ruth Warick; Rosalind Ho and Tasha Cox. As well CHHA members Dr. Kathy Pichora-Fuller (representing BCASLPA) and Tom Tylka, (teacher of the deaf and hard of hearing, retired) participated.
- CHHA issues raised included architectural accessibility- (example, the National Building Code and Provincial Building codes since 1985, contain a clause that all meeting rooms over 10 sq. metres should have installed a group listening device for the hard of hearing, yet this is not being enforced); employment and education issues; transportation and telephone issues and the need for flexibility in legislation, relative to changing technical standards.
- The need to include a mechanism to enforce clauses in the National Building Code was also stressed.

We would like to congratulate Elissa Robb, CHHA Vancouver Secretary and Registered Audiologist and Hearing Instrument Practitioner, on receiving the **Canadian Association of Educators of the Deaf and** Hard of Hearing BC Advocate Award for 2016-17! Elissa was recognized for her dedication to supporting deaf and hard of hearing students both in the field of audiology and in her work through the Post-Secondary Communication Access and Services Committee.
