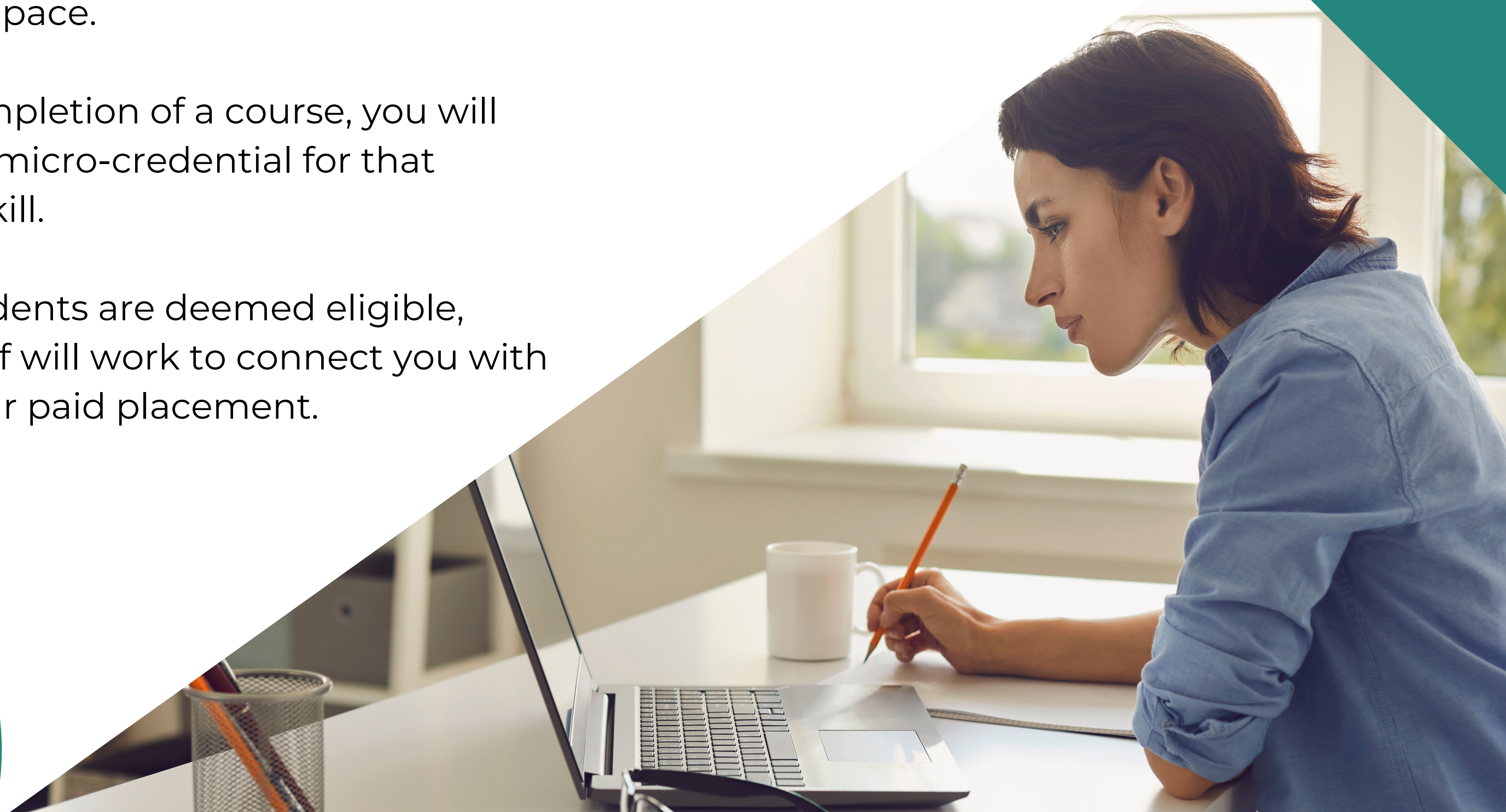
Learn and improve your skills in an accessible way.

We are looking for Deaf and Hard of Hearing (D/HOH) community members in British Columbia, Alberta, Ontario, and Nova Scotia to join the ANTE program.

To register, individuals must be unemployed, underemployed, or finishing post-secondary studies.

- There will be 9 no-cost online courses for you to complete. These courses will help to improve your foundational skills to help you succeed in the workforce.
- Each course takes approximately 30 hours to complete and you may learn at your own pace.
- Upon completion of a course, you will receive a micro-credential for that specific skill.
- Once students are deemed eligible, ANTE staff will work to connect you with a 200 hour paid placement.

ANTE has been designed to build academic and practical skills for members of the D/HOH community and support job placements to bridge the gap between employers' labour needs and D/HOH participants' employment needs.
